**AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE LOCAL CRISIS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (CMC) OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ILAGAN, PROVINCE OF ISABELA.**

**WHEREAS**, Crisis Management Committee (CMC) is a governing body that takes decisive actions to resolve crisis or emergency. It is primary concerned with the formulation of crisis management policies, integration and orchestration of government and public efforts towards the control of crisis or incidents;

**WHEREAS**, the executive order No. 320, series of 1988, "AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 309, 2,1987, S. 1988"; a special Action Committee shall be organized within the NPOC, composed of the secretary of Local Government, Secretary of National Defense, Secretary of Social Welfare and Development, Secretary of Justice and the AFP Chief of Staff, to take the decisive action in emergency situations;

**WHEREAS**, indicate the section 1-5 of the National Crisis Management Core Manual, CY 2012, Crisis Management Committee (CMC) are to be created within the Regional, Provincial, City or Municipal Peace and Order Councils, and within the Barangay Peace and Order Committee, with the local counterparts of representatives from the prescribed National-level Crisis Management Committee to form part of the local CMC when the need arises;

**WHEREAS**, the election into office of the new set of local officials mandates the reorganization of the committee;

**NOW THEREFOR, I JOSEMARIE L. DIAZ**, by virtue of authority vested in me by law as Local Chief Executive of the City of Ilagan, Isabela, do hereby create and organize the LOCAL CRISIS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (CMC) OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ILAGAN, PROVINCE OF ISABELA with the following provisions:

**Section 1. Composition of the CMC.**

### **Section 2. Responsibilities of the CMC Chairperson**

The following shall be the duties of the CMC Chairpersons:

- a. Designated a specific office to undertake or monitor crisis management efforts; and
- b. Perform responsibilities under five (5) components such as Predict, Prevent, Perform and Post-Action and Assessment.

### **Section 3. Responsibilities of the CMC**

The following shall be the duties of the CMC:

- a. Establish producers for producing timely direction and guidelines;
- b. Coordinate and implement responses to crisis in an integrated manner;
- c. Ensure that the perspective of government agencies and other stakeholders are integrated into the overall government response;
- d. Provide and mobilized available resources through an established interagency resource sharing protocol;
- e. Coordinate inter-agency crisis management efforts;
- f. Ensure the operational demands during the crisis are met in all action are coordinated and complimentary; and

- g. Established accessible communication lines so that reliable and timely information are received and disseminated to appropriate offices or persons responsible.

**Section 4. CMC Working Synergy with the Incident Command System.**

- a. The City of Ilagan shall organize the Incident command system (ICS) which is the structure designated to improve emergency response operations of all types and complexities and designate its Incident Commander (IC) who is the final decision-making authority on the ground in accordance to the nature of the crisis who shall report directly to the CMC Chairperson for guidance and instructions;
- b. The CMC Chairperson has the prerogative to create several ICS with different ICs to address specific types of crisis simultaneously;
- c. The CMC shall disrupt the operations of the ICs, but instead perform the following:
- Provide requirements of the ICs;
  - Coordinated and facilitate support from higher authorities ; and
  - Supervise the execution of the plan of action by members of the ICs once it has been established and operated
- d. The CMC shall only intervene in operations if:
- Actions undertaken by the ICs are not in accordance with those approved by the CMC; or
  - The CMC, during assessment finds that capabilities of committed forces or units are inappropriate or ineffective.
- e. The CMC shall be overall responsible and accountable unit, whatever the outcome of the conduct of the operations.


**Section 5. Meetings:** The Crisis Management Committee (CMC) shall convene every month; however, the Chairman may call for an emergency meeting as the need arises.

The PMC shall conduct regular ocular inspection of all projects upon coordination with the implementing agency / organization.

The Secretariat shall prepare a monthly report to be submitted to the City Mayor for his information and guidance.

**Section 6. Effectivity.** The Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
