AN ORDER CREATING THE CITY TASK FORCE TO END LOCAL COMMUNIST ARMED CONFLICT IN THE CITY OF ILAGAN.

WHEREAS, it is a declared State principle and policy "the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this State principle and policy, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Executive Order No. 16 s. 2017 which calls for the end of all armed threats in the Philippines and recognizes that internal socio-political stability rests upon healing the rifts that divide the nation by promoting participatory governance, synergy of government development efforts, and enhancing the participation and responsibilities of local government units;

WHEREAS, the Office of the President issued Executive Order No. 70 institutionalizing the whole-of-nation approach in attaining inclusive and sustainable peace, creating a national task force to end local communist armed conflict, and directing the adoption of a national peace framework;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this peace framework, and in consonance with the provisions of this Executive Orders, there is a need to create a task force in the city that will supervise and facilitate the objective of the national government in ending local communist armed conflict in the City of Ilagan;

NOW THEREFOR, I JOSEMARIE L. DIAZ, City Mayor, City of Ilagan, Isabela, by virtue of authority vested in me by law, do hereby create and organize the City Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict in the City of Ilagan

Section 2. Functions of the Task Force.

The Task Force shall have the following functions:

- a. Formulate a City peace framework and coordinate with concerned agencies in the implementation of the said peace framework.
- b. Consolidate all efforts and activities that gear towards the addressing the cause of conflict and the provision of support for livelihood, shelter, food, infrastructure, agriculture, peace and order, health, employment and others.
- c. Develop information and education strategies on peace-building initiatives, capacity building for members of the Task Force to enable them to engage and initiate peace engagements, negotiations, and interventions in local level.
- d. Submit recommendations to the Local Chief Executive that shall contribute to the attainment of peace and the establishment of peace initiatives in the City.
- e. Shall conduct regular meeting as may be determined by the majority of the members, and
- f. Perform such other functions as may be directed by the Local Chief Executive.

Section 3. Funding.

The City Government of Ilagan shall appropriate an amount sufficient to support the operations of the Task Force to be source from its general fund.

Section 4. Separability. In the event that any provision of this Order or any part hereof is declared invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, the provisions not thereby affected shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
