EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. **029** -

AN ORDER CREATING THE ILAGAN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (ILAGANDA) IN THE CITY OF ILAGAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Ilagan outlined its medium-term development program through the Executive Agenda of the Local Chief Executive, anchored on its thrust of transforming the City of Ilagan into a livable City in the year 2030;

WHEREAS, the Local Executive through the Ilagan Development Authority (ILAGANDA) shall maximize all talents within the City of Ilagan in harnessing their potentials to contribute relevant innovations in achieving the Executive Agenda;

WHEREAS, the Local Executive through the Ilagan Development Authority (ILAGANDA) shall strategically mobilize the human resources to ensure productivity in terms of outputs vis a vis delivery of quality service and give value to material resources to wisely utilize for intended purpose;

WHEREAS, the Local Executive through the Ilagan Development Authority (ILAGANDA) shall orchestrate skillfull Ilaguenos to give impetus to the five-point Executive Agenda for A liveable city;

WHEREAS, the Local Executive through the Ilagan Development Authority (ILAGANDA) shall etch the name of the City of Ilagan at the forefront being the fastest growing and most habitable City not only in the Province of Isabela but also in the Region and at par with the national standard situating the welfare of its people at the core of the Executive Roadmap;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEMARIE L. DIAZ, City Mayor of the City of Ilagan, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order that:

Section 1. The Ilagan Development Authority (ILAGANDA) is hereby created as the implementing arm of the development programs of the Local Executive with the following composition:

Section 2. Functions of the Task Force.

The Task Force shall have the following functions:

- a. Formulate a City peace framework and coordinate with concerned agencies in the implementation of the said peace framework.
- b. Consolidate all efforts and activities that gear towards the addressing the cause of conflict and the provision of support for livelihood, shelter, food, infrastructure, agriculture, peace and order, health, employment and others.
- c. Develop information and education strategies on peace-building initiatives, capacity building for members of the Task Force to enable them to engage and initiate peace engagements, negotiations, and interventions in local level.
- d. Submit recommendations to the Local Chief Executive that shall contribute to the attainment of peace and the establishment of peace initiatives in the City.
- e. Shall conduct regular meeting as may be determined by the majority of the members, and
- f. Perform such other functions as may be directed by the Local Chief Executive.


Section 3. Funding.

The City Government of Ilagan shall appropriate an amount sufficient to support the operations of the Task Force to be source from its general fund.

Section 4. Separability. In the event that any provision of this Order or any part hereof is declared invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, the provisions not thereby affected shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
