**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 031**  
Series of 2019

**AN ORDER BANNING THE ENTRY OF SWINE/HOGS/PIGS AND ITS BY PRODUCTS (FROZEN AND UNCOOK) IN THE CITY OF ILAGAN AND CREATING THE TASK FORCE ASF (AFRICAN SWINE FEVER) IN THE CITY OF ILAGAN, PRESCRIBING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, there exist a significant number of cases of the African Swine Fever in the Philippines which causes the deaths of considerable number of swine or hogs in the country;

WHEREAS, there are fears that the spread of this deadly strain may reach a more areas in the country, especially in Luzon, and may affect the health and the swine or hog industry in these areas;

WHEREAS, in order to prevent or limit the occurrence of infections into this city, there is a need to take precautionary measures to protect the swine or hogs industry in this city, and to further protect the health and ensure the safety of the Ilaguenos;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Executive Order No. 46 of the Provincial Governor Hon. RODOLFO T. ALBANO III, the City Government of Ilagan considers the banning of the entry of swine/hogs/pigs and its by-products (frozen and uncook) coming from any parts of the country into the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Ilagan;

WHEREAS, there is a need to implement in full force and effect the ban on the entry of swine or hogs with the creation of the Task Force ASF (African Swine Fever) in the City of Ilagan;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEMARIE L. DIAZ, City Mayor of the City of Ilagan, Isabela, and by the power vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Ban. The City Government of Ilagan bans the entry of swine/hogs/pigs and its by-products (frozen and uncook) coming from any parts of the country into the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Ilagan.

Section 2. Creation. The Task Force ASF (African Swine Fever) is hereby created in the City of Ilagan.

Section 3. Composition. The Task Force shall be composed of the following:

Section 4. Duties and Functions.

1. The Task Force shall establish checkpoints in all entrances coming into the City, especially in Barangays Alibagu, San Juan, Lullutan, and in the entrance into the New Ilagan Public Market, to enforce the ban.






2. The Task Force shall conduct inspection into existing markets, supermarkets, meatshops, meat stores, and other business establishments dispensing or selling meat or meat products, frozen or uncook) to ensure that no swine/hogs/pigs coming from outside the City from being dispense or sold.
3. The Task Force shall require that all swine/hogs/pigs to be slaughtered/butchered shall pass the inspection of the City Agricultural Officer, and shall certify that it is fit for human consumption.
4. The Task Force is mandated to confiscate any swine/hogs/pigs and its by-products from any individual or establishments procured or acquired in violation of this executive order and shall be disposed accordingly.
5. That in the event of contamination or infection from the African Swine Fever, shall recommend measures to contain the effect, pursuant to the policy of the national government, the Department of Agriculture and the Provincial Government of Isabela.
6. The Task Force shall endeavor to provide massive information on the matter of African Swine Fever, and the enforcement of the ban,
7. Shall perform such other duties and functions as the Local Chief Executive may deem necessary.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
